

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING APRIL 5th, 2025

SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES 2024
ACCOMPLISHMENTS

As in previous years, our main actions focused on education and care for the most deprived.

1. EDUCATION

Renewal of purchases of supplies (€8,830 or \$10,020)

The association funded school supplies for the 2024/2025 school year for 1,478 primary and secondary school students. Parents once again contributed €1 per student. This year again, our goal was not to exceed this amount.

Equipment: Purchase of 3 fans (€201 or \$230)

An "express" request was made by our Vice-President, Christine, for the purchase of 3 fans, 2 for a class of 67 students and a third for another class of 50 students.

2. HEALTH

• Care for the most deprived (€2,019 or \$2280)

In the three municipalities (Namakia, Mitsinjo, Antongomena), the number of patients reached 849, which was 85 more than in 2023. The main illnesses were viral influenza and malaria almost year-round.

We also noted that the cost of care per person had increased by 0.30 cents, due to the rise in the cost of medication

3. Projects not completed in 2024

• Equipment for schools: Still waiting for a quote.

Lime for the buildings of 6 schools & anti-rust paint for a roof

Dental hygiene awareness in schools (€500 or \$570)

Oral hygiene training could not be carried out as planned in 2024 due to the lack of availability of caregivers from Majunga.

• Medical Office Equipment (€500 or \$570)

Oxygen extractor
